ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Is a member of an active local sister city with an affiliation in Mexico and a member in good standing of the US/MSCA.
- Applicant must be a high school or a college student between the ages of 14 to 25 years of age.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from:
 1. Member sister city association
 2. Teacher, school counselor or proof of current college enrollment.
- Submit a typed 300 word essay on “How does culture affect attitudes and customs, give examples. Recount your most memorable sister city experience.
